Industrial visit:

The department in addition to providing technical knowledge in the classroom also encourages students to gather the practical knowledge of ongoing projects and for this purpose an Industrial Visit was arranged for the students of Semester VI in Jan 2012. The main aim of this visit was to study the hydro-electric complex Tehri Dam situated in Nainital. The Tehri Dam is a multi-purpose rock and earth-fill embankment dam on the Bhagirathi River near Tehri in Uttarakhand, India. Phase 1 was completed in 2006, the Tehri Dam withholds a reservoir for irrigation, municipal water supply and the generation of 1,000 MW of hydroelectricity. Two more phases with an additional 400 MW run-of-the-river and 1,000 MW pumped storage hydroelectricity are under construction. The construction of dam was completed in 2006.

Expert Lecture On Advancement in Water Proofing:

Expert Lecture on 'Advancement in Water proofing' was conducted for the students of final year on 8th February 2012. Mrs. Seema Sugare, Assistant Manager, training department of Dr.Fixit Institute, Pidilite Industries, delivered the lecture.
