



- The Seminar was ended by Vote Of Thanks and Vande Mataram. Hence, Conducted Seminar On Civil Services Sucessfully.









#### Recommendations:

All details were shared and discussed with HOD madam, the class advisor and students, as & when required. However, as per the views shared:

- Modules may prove to be additionally beneficial if students are regular and the seriousness towards the cause is maintained. This would help in increased participation following a proper sequence
- As an option, a final sorted & selected list can be prepared for the students showing larger interest. This may avoid unnecessary peer pressures & disturbance to the ones interested, ensuring complete participation.
- It has been an enriching experience to train the young students.
