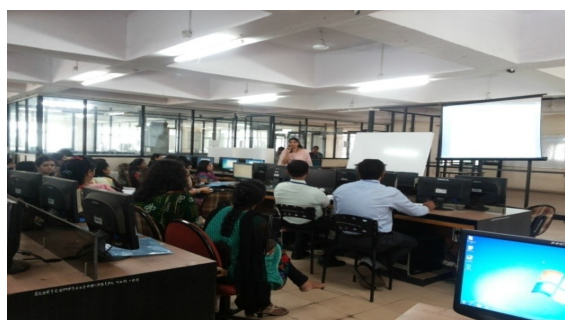
### **STTP on “Android O.S.” (2 -6 Dec.13)**

**Saraswati Education Society** organized **National level marathon** on September 17, 2013.

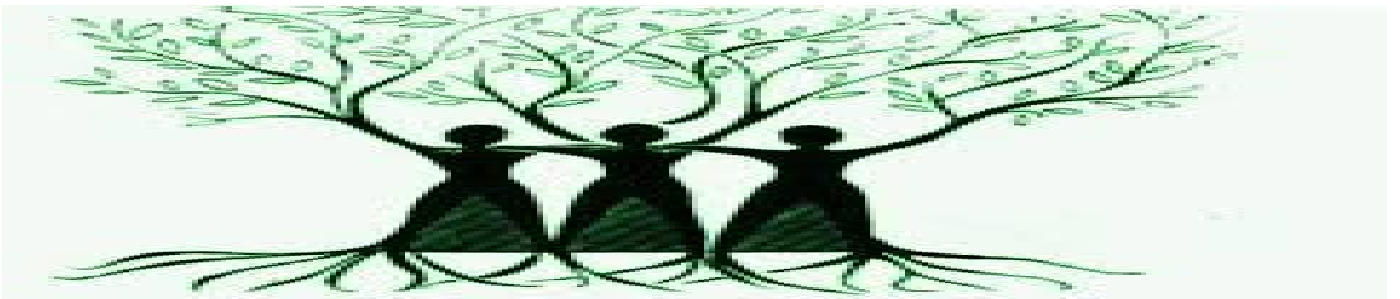
There was overwhelming response with over 3000 participants of every age group running for the cause of 'Woman Safety' and 'student wellness'. Out of these, **1500 participants** were
