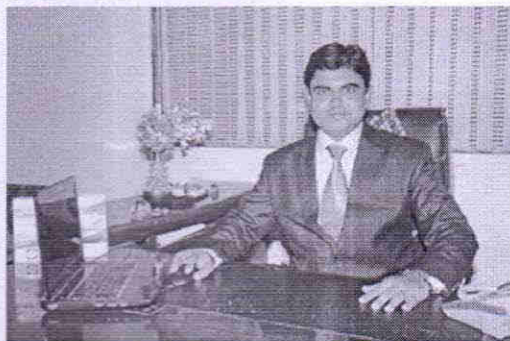

In Nakshatra 2014, our BE students coordinated the Web Designing Contest at college level. 17 students participated in contest. Winners were felicitated with certificates.

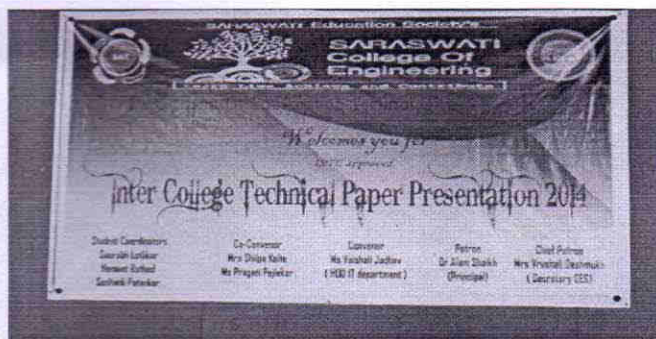


Coding Competition (25th Feb 2014)

Inter college technical paper presentation (26th Feb 2014)



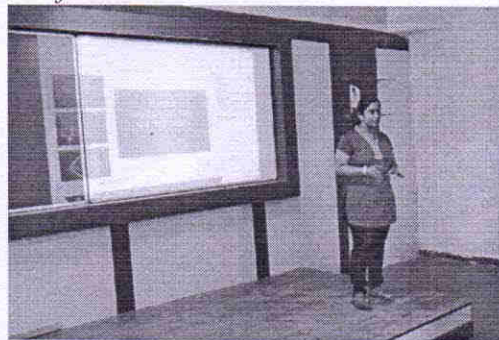

event.

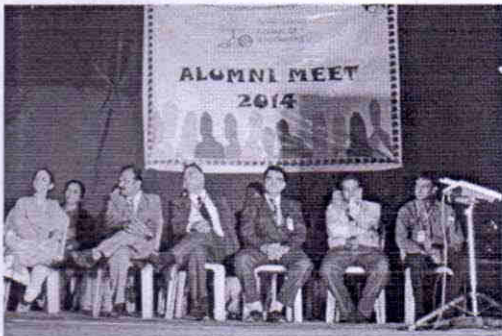
