4. The volunteers Cleaned the Areas around Kharghar Railway Station , most importantly Food stall area where lot of People Ent foods and throw plates.

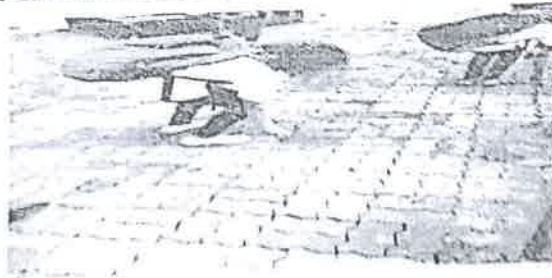
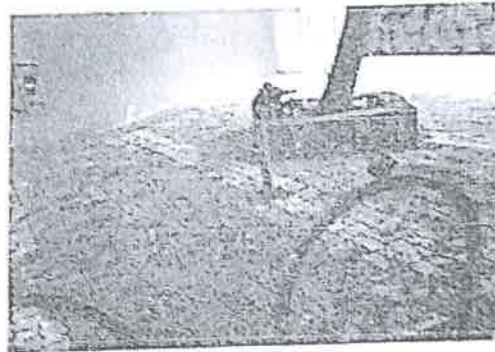
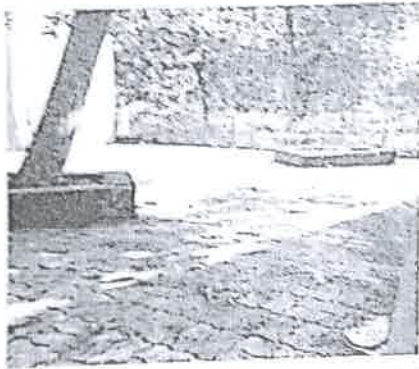

1. To motivate people to take care of their health and to make them start working out, by posing interesting looking challenges, and challenging them for the same to complete them, while keeping them in the public eye.
2. To make working out an enjoyable process and set-up an accountability system of whether one has worked out a specific day or not.
3. To promote health and fitness, and inspire people to take care of their bodies.

-Rtr. Sairaj and Rtr. Jeevan promoted the project details on all Social Media Platforms. Also on the College's Notice Board and publicised Mouth to Mouth.

-The Project jpegs were made by Rtr. Ashish Pawar and Rtr. Rutuja.

-The Project PR Message was prepared by Rtr. Jeevan.

-Workout Routines, proper poses and workout charts were prepared by Rtr.Sairaj and Rtr. Jeevan with Intense research online.

-Every morning Rtr. Sairaj or Rtr. Jeevan, one of them, would share the list of people who did, and didn't do their workout the previous day, in all the Zonal, and the Club's CORE, BOD, and GBM Whatsapp groups.

Summary:

- The Phase 1 of the Go Harder Challenge was a 30 Day 50 Pushups Challenge which started on 1st October 2017.

-The participants were added to the Whatsapp group named 'The Go Harder Challenge' and explained the rules and expectations of the Challenge. The group was then divided into 2, one for boys and one for girls, to make sure that the female participants can freely post their videos.

-Everyday, the Day's task was added in the Whatsapp Group-name, and also mentioned in the group in the form of a message.

-Everyday, everyone sent their workout videos in their respective groups.

-The CPs checked whether they did the day's counts and also their postures in the initial days to ensure that they don't injure themselves doing something incorrectly.

-The list of the people who did and didn't do their workouts that day was forwarded in all Zonal and Club groups, as mentioned in the challenge rules, the following morning.

-The 30 Pushup Challenge ended on 30th October 2018, with an amazing and overwhelmingly positive response.

- The Phase 2 of The Go Harder Series of Challenges was a 11 Day- 7 Minute Plank Challenge which started on 21st December 2017.

-The proceedings were same as that in phase 1, as groups were created, separate for girls and boys, rules were explained, videos were posted in the groups, and lists were shared.

-The Plank Challenge ended on 31st December 2017, too with a good response.

- The Phase 3 of the Go Harder Challenges was a 45 Day- Weight Gain and Weight Loss Challenge which started on 17th April 2018.

-The other proceedings of the challenge remained the same.

-This challenge had international participants also, which was a very proud part for the CPs and for the Club as well.

-The Weight Gain and Weight Loss Challenge ended on 31st May 2018.

7. Everyone participated in Cyclothon with full of happiness and enthusiasm.

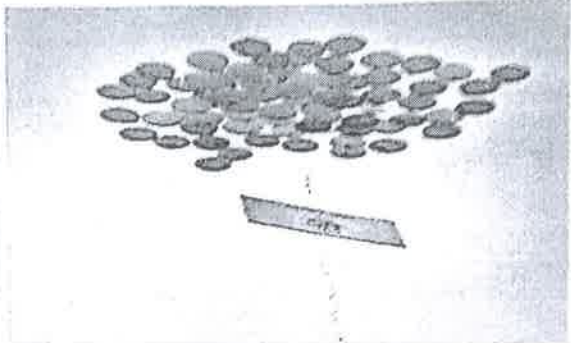

5. Winners were announced on 16th January, 2018 and during Road Safety Awareness seminar medals and prizes were given to winners.

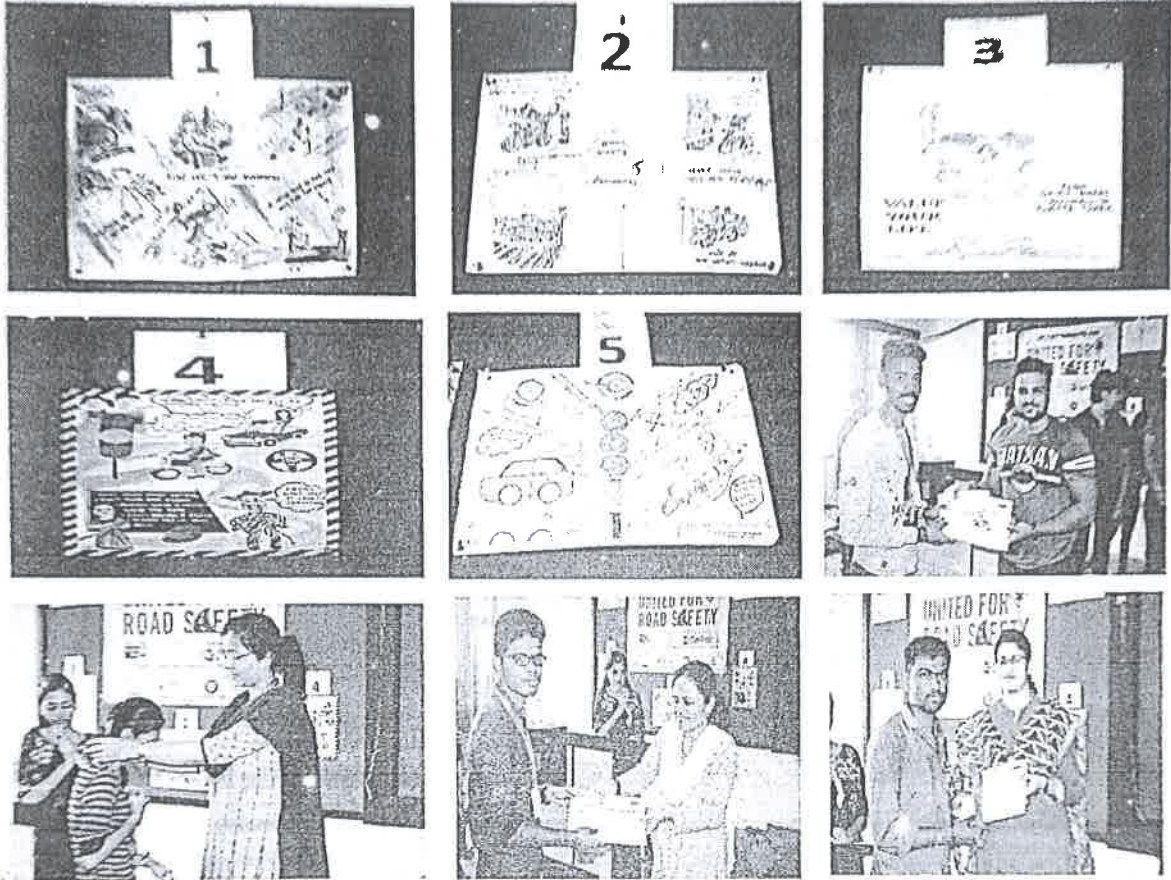

- They also shown some PPT and videos to educate everyone .



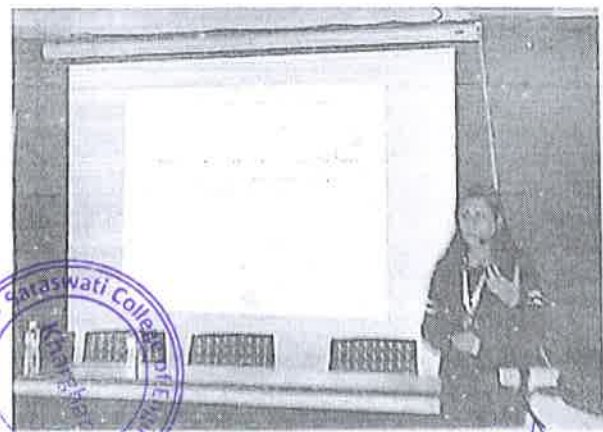

5. Taking up this drive made the footpaths clean and usable for the local people.



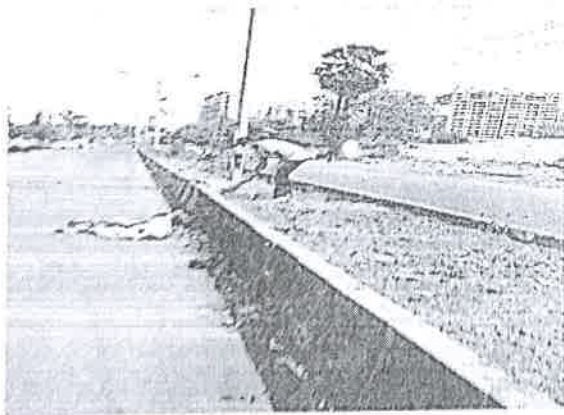
