CRICKET TOURNAMENT

every year cricket tournament held in scoe as per student demand and with some entry fee prize distribution is done in prize distribution ceremony .Cricket is a bat-and-ball game played between two teams, of eleven players each on a field at the centre of which is a 22-yard (20-metre) pitch with a wicket at each end, each comprising two bails balanced on three stumps. First played: 16th century; South-East England cricket, England's national summer sport, which is now played throughout the world. There are two batsman up at a time, and the batsman being bowled to (the striker) tries to hit the ball away from the wicket. A hit may be defensive or offensive. A defensive hit may protect the wicket but leave the batsmen no time to run to the opposite wicket. In that case the batsmen need not run, and play will resume with another bowl. If the batsman can make an offensive hit, he and the second batsman (the nonstriker) at the other wicket change places. Each time both batsmen can reach the opposite wicket, one run is scored. Providing they have enough time without being caught out and dismissed, the batsmen may continue to cross back and forth between the wickets, earning an additional run for each time both reach the opposite side. There is an outside boundary around the cricket field. A ball hit to or beyond the boundary scores four points if it hits the ground and then reaches the boundary, six points if it reaches the boundary from the air (a fly ball). The team with the highest number of runs wins a match. Should both teams be unable to complete their number of innings before the time allotted, the match is declared a draw.

KABADDI


Kabaddi is not a sport meant for faint-hearted ones. Generally, A kabaddi match is played among two teams with 7 players on each side. Anyone who wishes to be a kabaddi player has to make sure that he/she has a good lung capacity with an amazing presence of mind and of course the much needed muscular strength. Talking further about the kabaddi field, it is generally divided into two parts. Here, the players are classified as the antis and the raiders. The players on the defensive side are known as the antis whereas the ones on offence are known as the raiders. Kabaddi is played on both national and international levels. When played on an international level, the dimensions of court for men is 10m x 13m whereas for women the dimension is 8m x 12m. During the game, a raider is considered to be out when he/she crosses the boundary line, can't hold their breath, a part of their body touches the lobby. Generally, six officials are appointed for supervising the match. These officials are as follows:


No of players: 7+4

KHO-KHO TOURNAMENT

KHO-KHO

Every year Kho Kho Tournament held in SCOE as per student demand and various departmental; students participated in this tournament. Kho Kho is a traditional Indian sport, being one of the oldest outdoor sports dating back to ancient India. [1] It is the second most popular traditional tag game in the Indian subcontinent after Kabaddi.[2] Kho-Kho is played on a rectangular court with a central lane connecting two poles which are at either end of the court. During the game, nine players from the chasing team (attacking team) are on the field, with eight of them sitting (crouched) in the central lane, while three "runners" from the defending team run around the court and try to avoid being touched.[3] Each sitting player on the chasing team sits facing alternating directions from the central lane. At any time, one player on the chasing team (the "active chaser"

or "attacker") may run around the court to attempt to tag (touch) members of the defending team, with one point scored per tag, and each tagged defender required to leave the field; however, the active chaser can not cross the central lane to access the other half of the field, and also must only run in the direction (facing either pole) they took their first step in. The chasing team can get around these restrictions if the active chaser either switches roles with a sitting teammate (by touching them on the back while saying "Kho") who is facing the other half of the court and therefore has access to it, or runs to either pole and then switches direction/half. Each team has two turns to score and two turns to defend, with each turn lasting nine minutes. The team that scores the most points by the end of the game wins

Kho-Kho

No of players: - 9+3

Rules: All players, coaches, referees, timekeepers or any person is referred in these rules must know the rules of the game and abide by the rules.

1.A team consist of 12 Players, 9 Players will take the Field in the beginning to start the match and 3 substitutes.

Volleyball Tournament

Every year volleyball tournament held in scoe in which various departments team participated. Game played by two teams, usually of six players on a side, in which the players use their hands to bat a ball back and forth over a high net, trying to make the ball touch the court within the opponents' playing area before it can be returned. To prevent this a player on the opposing team bats the ball up and toward a teammate before it touches the court surface—that teammate may then volley it back across the net or bat it to a third teammate who volleys it across the net. A team is allowed only three touches of the ball before it must be returned over the net. Volleyball is a popular sport that is played professionally, as well as in recreational leagues, on school teams, in backyards, sandlots, or beaches. The game of volleyball can be enjoyed virtually anywhere a net can be set up, including over a swimming pool. A typical volleyball game uses six players on each side. The aim is to deliver the ball over the net and "ground" it (have it touch the ground) on the opposing side while preventing the ball from touching the ground on their side.

VOLLEY BALL


No of players: - 6+3 Rules

- 3) Score must be said aloud by each server for each serve.



RELAY and 100 m Race TOURNAMENT

Every year relay and 100 m race competition held in SCOE A relay race is a racing competition where members of a team take turns completing parts of racecourse or performing a certain action. Relay races take the form of professional races and amateur games. Relay races are common in running, orienteering, swimming, cross-country skiing, biathlon, or ice skating (usually with a baton in the fist). In the Olympic Games, there are several types of relay races that are part of track and field. Relay race, also called Relay, a track-and-field sport consisting of a set number of stages (legs), usually four, each leg run by a different member of a team. The runner finishing one leg is usually required to pass the next runner a stick-like object known as a "baton" while both are running in a marked exchange zone. In most relays, team members cover equal distances: Olympic events for both men and women are the 400-metre (4×100 -metre) and 1,600-metre (4×400 -metre) relays. Some non-Olympic relays are held at distances of 800 m, 3,200 m, and 6,000 m. In the less frequently run medley relays, however, the athletes cover different distances in a prescribed order—as in a sprint medley of 200, 200, 400, 800 metres or a distance medley of 1,200, 400, 800, 1,600 metres.

MEHNDI COMPETITION

Mehandi competition every year held in SCOE in which various girls from various department participated and showcase their art skill . Mehndi paste is usually applied to the skin using a plastic cone, a paintbrush or a stick. After about 15–20 minutes, the mud will dry and begin to crack, and during this time, a mixture of lemon juice and white sugar can be applied over the henna design to remoisten the henna mud so that the henna will stain darker. The painted area is then wrapped with tissue, plastic, or medical tape to lock in body heat, creating a more intense colour on the skin.

Mehndi

- Materials like henna, cloth should be brought by participants itself.
- Participants must bring their partners with them.
- Minimum two hands must be covered with Henna. Products like Instant Henna, body stickers are not allowed.
- Participants must make sure that their products are safe for their partners. Expired goods must be avoided.

- Participants must not mention their details anywhere on the design. Identity should be kept anonymous until the results



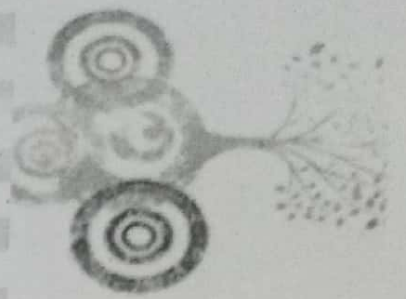

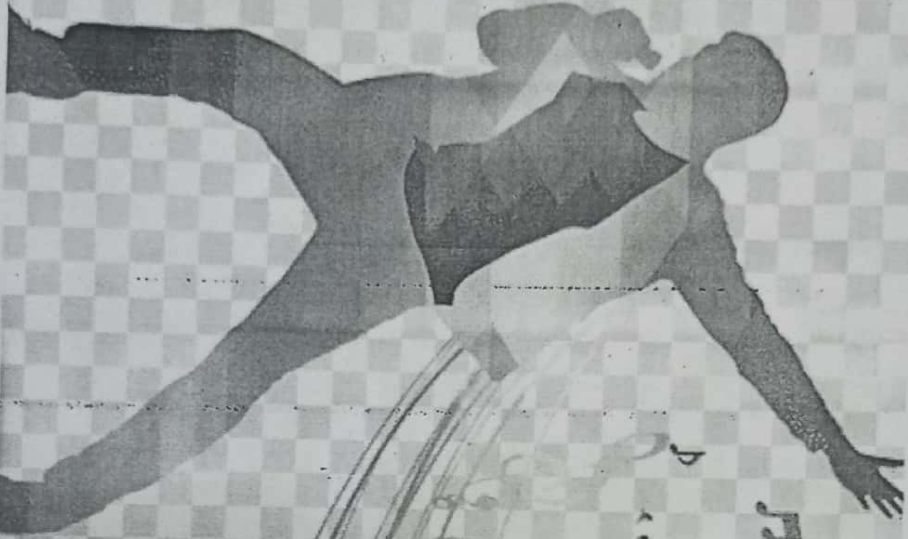

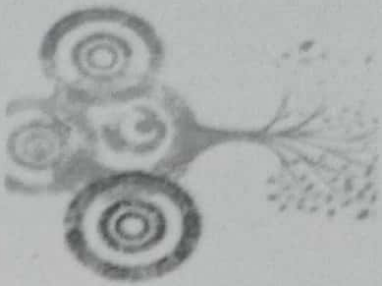

- A maximum team of 3 is allowed.



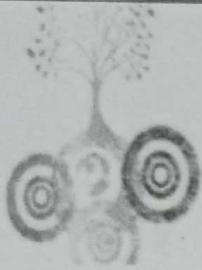

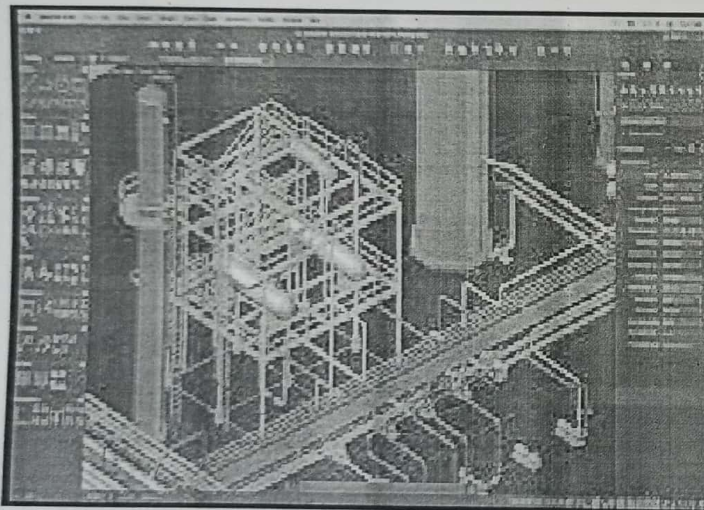
