Professional singers usually take voice training provided by voice teachers or vocal coaches throughout their careers.

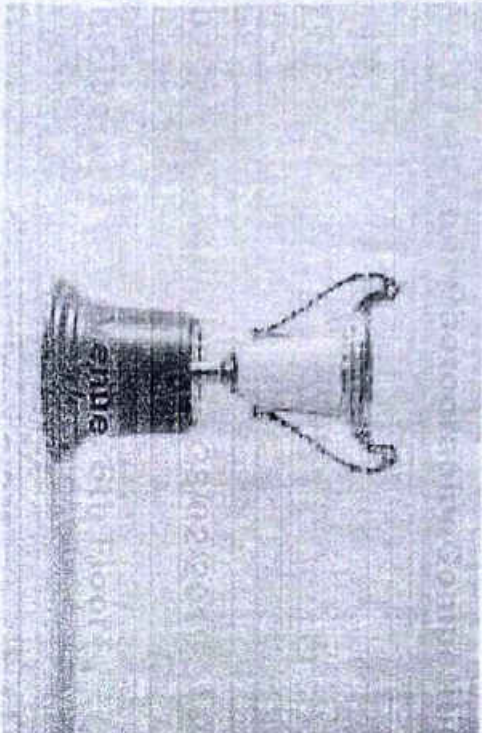

FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT

SCOPE every year conducts Football Tournament as per student demand in this different department from the team and participates in competition, with minimum fees, certificates and trophy distributed among students. Football, also called association football or soccer, is a game involving two teams of 11 players who try to maneuver the ball into the other team's goal without using their hands or arms. The team that scores more goals wins. Football is the world's most popular ball game in numbers of participants and spectators. football, also called association football or soccer, game in which two teams of 11 players, using any part of their bodies except their hands and arms, try to maneuver the ball into the opposing team's goal. Only the goalkeeper is permitted to handle the ball and may do so only within the penalty area surrounding the goal. The team that scores more goals wins.

FOOTBALL

No. of players (11+6) Rules:

1. Standard FIFA rules will be followed throughout the game.
2. The team consists of 11 playing players with 6 subs.
3. Arguing with referees won't be entertained.
4. Each half consists of 15 mins each with a break of 5 mins.
5. Each team will wear the same colour jersey.
6. Each Department will be consisting of a single team. (Except FE)



7. Standard league matches Card The referee and the umpire can use the following cards to warn, temporarily suspend, suspend from the match or debar from the tournament a player/team.

- a) Green Card: Warning if green card is shown to a player/team. Team twice, then the next card shall be directly Yellow Card.
- b) Yellow Card: Opposition team will get plus 1 point.
- c) Red Card: Team will Disqualify.

every year cricket tournament held in scoe as per student demand and with some entry fee prize distribution is done in prize distribution ceremony .Cricket is a bat-and-ball game played between two teams of eleven players each on a field at the centre of which is a 22-yard (20-metre) pitch with a wicket at each end, each comprising two bails balanced on three stumps. First played: 16th century; South-East England cricket, England's national summer sport, which is now played throughout the world. There are two batsman up at a time, and the batsman being bowled to (the striker) tries to hit the ball away from the wicket. A hit may be defensive or offensive. A defensive hit may protect the wicket but leave the batsmen no time to run to the opposite wicket. In that case the batsmen need not run, and play will resume with another bowl. If the batsman can make an offensive hit, he and the second batsman (the nonstriker) at the other wicket change places. Each time both batsmen can reach the opposite wicket, one run is scored. Providing they have enough time without being caught out and dismissed, the batsmen may continue to cross back and forth between the wickets, earning an additional run for each time both reach the opposite side. There is an outside boundary around the cricket field. A ball hit to or beyond the boundary scores four points if it hits the ground and then reaches the boundary, six points if it reaches the boundary from the air (a fly ball). The team with the highest number of runs wins a match. Should both teams be unable to complete their number of innings before the time allotted, the match is declared a draw.

KABADDI TOURNAMENT

KABADDI

Kabaddi is not a sport meant for faint-hearted ones. Generally, A kabaddi match is played among two teams with 7 players on each side. Anyone who wishes to be a kabaddi player has to make sure that he/she has a good lung capacity with an amazing presence of mind and of course the much needed muscular strength. Talking further about the kabaddi field, it is generally divided into two parts. Here, the players are classified as the antis and the raiders. The players on the defensive side are known as the antis whereas the ones on offence are known as the raiders. Kabaddi is played on both national and international levels. When played on an international level, the dimensions of court for men is 10m x 13m whereas for women the dimension is 8m x 12m. During the game, a raider is considered to be out when he/she crosses the boundary line, can't hold their breath, a part of their body touches the lobby. Generally, six officials are appointed for supervising the match. These officials are as follows:

No of players: 7+4

1. The team that wins the toss shall have the choice of the court or the raid and the team that loses the toss shall have the remaining choice.
2. A player shall be out if any part of his body touches the ground outside the boundary but during the struggle a player shall not be out if any part of his body



touches the ground outside the boundary by keeping contact of the playfield. The portion of contact must be inside the boundary.

3. If any player goes out of the boundary during the course of play, he shall be out. The Umpire or Referee shall try to take out such players at once. The Umpire or Referee shall declare such players out by calling out the numbers. No whistle shall be blown as the raid may continue. If an anti or antis who have gone out of bounds (as per rule 03 a), hold a raider, the raider shall be declared NOT OUT. The anti or antis who have gone out of bounds only will be declared out.
4. When the struggle begins, the play field includes the lobbies. During the struggle and after the struggle in the same raid, the players involved in the struggle can use the lobbies to enter their respective courts. This rule will only be applicable in the anti's court.
5. A raider shall continue to chant "KABADDI" as the approved chant. If he is not keeping the proper approved cant in the opponent's court, he shall be ordered back and the opponent will be given one technical point and chance to raid. Under such circumstances, he shall not be pursued.
6. A raider must start his chant before he touches the opponent's court. If he starts the chant late, he shall be ordered back by the Umpire or Referee and the opponent will be given one technical point & a chance to raid.
7. If a raider goes out of turn, the Umpire or Referee shall order him to go back and a technical point will be given to opponent team.
8. Not more than one raider shall enter the opponent's court at a time, if more than one raider enters the opponent's court at a time, the Umpire or Referee shall order all to go back to their court and a technical point will be awarded to the opponent and chance to raid.
9. After a raider has reached his court or is put out in the opponent's court, the opponents shall send their raider within 5 Seconds. Thus alternately each side shall send their raider until the end of the game.



In case the raider fails to start his raid within 5 seconds the team loses its chance to raid and the opponent team gets a technical point.

10. If a raider, who is caught by the anti or antis, escapes from their attempt to hold and reaches his court safely he shall not be pursued. Note: But if a raider touches the anti or antis and reaches back to his court safely he may be pursued.

11. If a raider, while in the opponent's court loses his chant, he shall be out.

12. When a raider is held, the antis shall not try deliberately to stifle his chant by shutting his mouth, using violent tackling leading to injuries, any type of scissoring or use of any unfair means. If such incident happens, the Umpire or Referee shall declare the raider NOT

OUT. (For punishment see no. 3 & 4 of the rules under heading "Officials").

13. No anti shall wilfully push the raider out of the boundary by any part of his (Anti's) body, nor shall any raider wilfully push or pull an anti or antis out of the boundary. If the raider is pushed outside the boundary or the anti is pushed or pulled outside the boundary, the Umpire or Referee shall declare the raider or the anti, as the case may be, as NOT OUT, and the anti or the raider who pushes or pulls the opponents outside the boundary shall be declared out.

14. During the course of raid none of the antis shall touch the raider's court until completion of the raid. In case any anti or antis touches the raider's court before completion of the raid they will be declared out and the opponent team will be given that many points.

15. If an anti or antis who are out, having violated Rule No.14, holds a raider or have violated the said rule while holding or helping to hold the raider, the raider shall be declared NOT OUT and the anti or antis who touches the raider's court shall be declared OUT.

16. When a team manages to put out the entire opponent team and none of the opponents are entitled to be revived, then that team scores

a LONA and two extra points for LONA shall be awarded in addition to the points scored by the team putting out all the players of the opponent. The play



continues and all the players who are out shall enter in their court within Ten Seconds. Otherwise the referee or umpire shall award one technical point to the opponent. If the team fails to enter within one minute, the team shall be scratched from the match and the match shall be awarded to the opponent.

17. If a raider is warned or in any way instructed by one of his own side, the Umpire or Referee shall award one technical point to the opponent.

18. A raider or an anti is not to be held by any part of his body deliberately other than his limb or trunk. The one who violates the rule shall be declared OUT. If the raider is held deliberately other than his limb or trunk, the Umpire or Referee shall declare such raider NOT OUT.

Note: If a raider is caught by his clothes or hair the raider shall be declared NOT OUT and the anti or antis who have violated the Rule

No.18 shall be declared OUT

19. When one or two players of a team are left during the game and the Captain of the team declares them out in order to bring in the fullteam, the opponent shall score as many points as the players that existed in the court at the time of declaration as well as Two Extra Points for LONA.

20. A Player or players who are out shall be revived in the same order as they were out when one or more opponents are out.

21. Every player should have their own shoes for match. Cards The referee and the umpire can use the following cards to warn, temporarily suspend, suspend from the match or debar from the tournament a player/team.

a) Green Card Warning if green card is shown to a player/ coach/ manager / Team twice, then the next card shall be directly Yellow Card.

b) Yellow Card Temporary Suspension for 2 Minutes. If yellow card is shown to player/ team, then the next card shall be directly Red Card. As well as opposition points will be increase by 5 point.



Note:

The two minutes suspension of players shall commence from the time the player is on court only

If the out player is suspended for two minutes than the suspension will begin after revival Teams will not be allowed to revive the next out player in place of the suspended player revival

KHO-KHO TOURNAMENT

KHO-KHO

Every year Kho Kho Tournament held in SCOE as per student demand and various departmental; students participated in this tournament. Kho Kho is a traditional Indian sport, being one of the oldest outdoor sports dating back to ancient India. [1] It is the second most popular traditional tag game in the Indian subcontinent after Kabaddi. [2] Kho-Kho is played on a rectangular court with a central lane connecting two poles which are at either end of the court. During the game, nine players from the chasing team (attacking team) are on the field, with eight of them sitting (crouched) in the central lane, while three "runners" from the defending team run around the court and try to avoid being touched. [3] Each sitting player on the chasing team sits facing alternating directions from the central lane. At any time, one player on the chasing team (the "active chaser"

or "attacker") may run around the court to attempt to tag (touch) members of the defending team, with one point scored per tag, and each tagged defender required to leave the field; however, the active chaser can not cross the central lane to access the other half of the field, and also must only run in the direction (facing either pole) they took their first step in. The chasing team can get around these restrictions if the active chaser either switches roles with a sitting teammate (by touching them on the back while saying "Kho") who is facing the other half of the court and therefore has access to it, or runs to either pole and then switches direction/half. Each team has two turns to score and two turns to defend, with each turn lasting nine minutes. The team that scores the most points by the end of the game wins

Kho-Kho

No of players: - 9+3

Rules: All players, coaches, referees, timekeepers or any person is referred in these rules must know the rules of the game and abide by the rules.

GENERAL RULES:

1. A team consist of 12 Players, 9 Players will take the Field in the beginning to start the match and 3 substitutes.



2. An inning will consist of Chasing and Defence turns which shall be of 9 minutes each for Men/Women.

3.3 Runners shall enter in the Court in a batch of three for their Defence. Subsequently, next 3 Runners shall enter the Court through their Entry Zone only. When third/last Defender of a batch is declared out, next 3

Runners shall be inside the court before two KHOS are given. Those Runners who fail to enter within the time lapse of two KHOS shall be declared out for having entered late (Late Entry).

4. The Runners shall continue to enter the Court for Defence in the same batch until the end of the turn. The order of batch shall not be changed during a turn. If a Defender is declared out by showing RED CARD by the

Referee, a substitute is allowed to Defending side and the substituted player shall enter with the same batch, if they have to come inside in the same turn.

5. The Runners who may enter early shall not be declared out but called back by Referee/Scorer

6. An Attacker who put out the last Defender of the batch shall not chase the new batch of Defenders. He shall give KHO, if attacks, it shall be Foul.

7. After giving a KHO, if any of the Runners enter the Court, Attacker is allowed to chase the Defender. It is not compulsory to give two KHOS to chase a Defender who has already entered.

8. As soon as the first Defender of a batch is out, next batch of Runners shall occupy the Entry Zone. Each side shall enter its Runners to the Court through their Entry Zone only.

Volleyball Tournament

Every year volleyball tournament held in scoe in which various departments team participated. Game played by two teams, usually of six players on a side, in which the players use their hands to bat a ball back and forth over a high net, trying to make the ball touch the court within the opponents' playing area before it can be returned. To prevent this a player on the opposing team bats the ball up and toward a teammate before it touches the court surface—that teammate may then volley it back across the net or bat it to a third teammate who volleys it across the net. A team is allowed only three touches of the ball before it must be returned over the net. Volleyball is a popular sport that is played professionally, as well as in recreational leagues, on school teams, in backyards, sandlots, or beaches. The game of volleyball can be enjoyed virtually anywhere a net can be set up, including over a swimming pool. A typical volleyball game uses six players on each side. The aim is to deliver the ball over the net and "ground" it (have it touch the ground) on the opposing side while preventing the ball from touching the ground on their side.

VOLLEY BALL

No of players: - 6+3 Rules

- 1) If both teams have 6 players present, the match will be played 6 vs 6. A team with 3 players substitute.
- 2) Volley for serve and side. Ball must cross the net 3 times before the ball is



live. If team A wins the volley, team B will serve the second game. If a third game is played, another volley for serve and side should be done.

- 3) Score must be said aloud by each server for each serve.
- 4) A serve contacting the net, but falling into the receiving teams' court will be considered legal and in play. A serve that contacts the net and lands in the serving teams' court or lands out of bounds will result in a side-out.
- 5) Teams are allowed one 30-second time-out per game.
- 6) 3 sets of 25 points for Boys and 3 sets 15 for Girls

Rotation: Teams must rotate appropriately, in a clockwise manner

Illegal Hits

An illegal hit is:

- 1) Slapping the ball,
- 2) Bumping the ball with two separated hands (hands must be together),
- 3) Carrying the ball,
- 4) Palming the ball,
- 5) Bobbling the serve (hitting the ball two separate times),
- 6) Directing the ball (throwing).

**** Card System:**

RELAY and 100 m Race TOURNAMENT

Every year relay and 100 m race competition held in SCOE A relay race is a racing competition where members of a team take turns completing parts of racecourse or performing a certain action. Relay races take the form of professional races and amateur games. Relay races are common in running, orienteering, swimming, cross-country skiing, biathlon, or ice skating (usually with a baton in the fist). In the Olympic Games, there are several types of relay races that are part of track and field. Relay race, also called Relay, a track-and-field sport consisting of a set number of stages (legs), usually four, each leg run by a different member of a team. The runner finishing one leg is usually required to pass the next runner a stick-like object known as a "baton" while both are running in a marked exchange zone. In most relays, team members cover equal distances: Olympic events for both men and women are the 400-metre (4 × 100-metre) and 1,600-metre (4 × 400-metre) relays. Some non-Olympic relays are held at distances of 800 m, 3,200 m, and 6,000 m. In the less frequently run medley relays, however, the athletes cover different distances in a prescribed order—as in a sprint medley of 200, 200, 400, 800 metres or a distance medley of 1,200, 400, 800, 1,600 metres.

RELAY

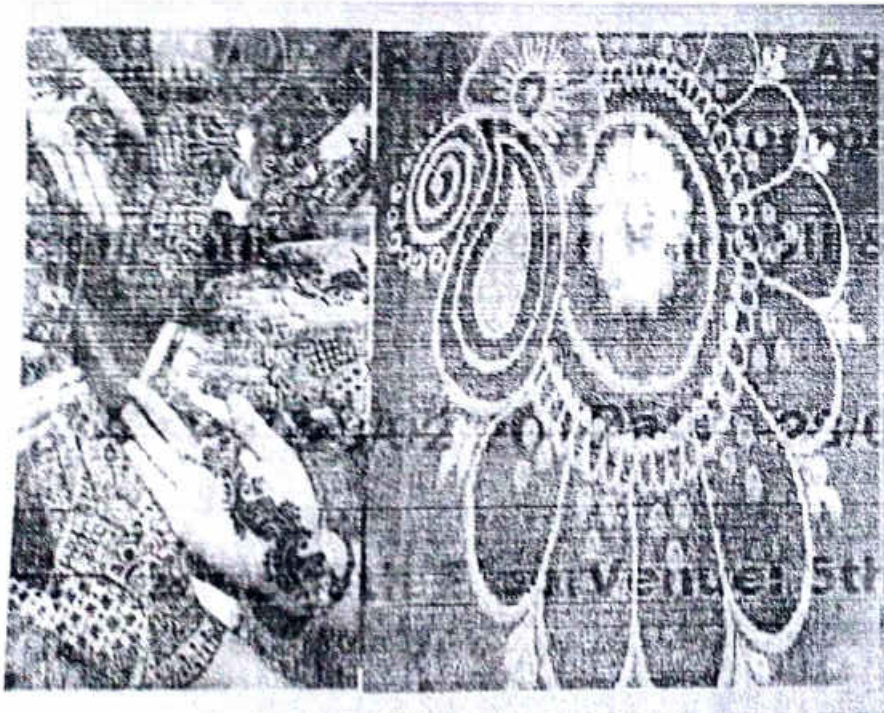





MEHNDI COMPETITION

Mehandi competition every year held in SCOE in which various girls from various department participated and showcase their art skill . Mehndi paste is usually applied to the skin using a plastic cone, a paintbrush or a stick. After about 15–20 minutes, the mud will dry and begin to crack, and during this time, a mixture of lemon juice and white sugar can be applied over the henna design to remoisten the henna mud so that the henna will stain darker. The painted area is then wrapped with tissue, plastic, or medical tape to lock in body heat, creating a more intense colour on the skin.

Mehndi

THROWBALL

No of players: - 7+3 Rules:

1. Each team should consist of seven (7) players at time of play.
2. The team shall consist of 7 active players and 3 substitutes.
3. The match should be played for best of 3 sets for 25 points in each set with rally score.
4. Any ball to be released should be released from above the /shoulder-line only.
5. The ball has to be caught with both hands and returned in one only.
6. Service balls should not touch the net.
7. Double touch is not allowed for the service ball.
8. The ball should be served after the whistle & within 5 seconds.
9. Serve the ball only from the service- -zone & without crossing the end line.
10. Any ball falling on the box line or in the dead zone is a foul.
11. Any ball after catching (during rally) should be released within 3 seconds.
12. During the rally, the ball can touch the net.
13. Body touch- during catching or releasing the ball should not touch any part



of the body except the palm.

14. Dubs- while catching, the ball should be caught simultaneously with both the hands.
15. Two players cannot catch the ball simultaneously.
16. Any ball (service/rally) falling on the side-line or the end-line is a good ball.
17. The players should stay in 2-3-2 positions at the time of service.
18. Shifting the ball from right to left or left to right is not permitted.
19. Pushing the ball deliberately is not permitted.
20. The service ball or the rally ball should not touch the antenna.
21. 2 substitutions are allowed for each set.
22. Two time-outs of (30 seconds each) are permitted for each set.
23. The players should wear proper uniform (shorts & jersey)
24. Identity Cards are compulsory.
