GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS :


- The names, details of all the participants of all competitions/ titles will be submitted beforehand by the departmental committees.

CHESS TOURNAMENT

Every year SCOE arranged Chess competition for students. Chess is an abstract strategy game and involves no hidden information. It is played on a square chessboard with 64 squares arranged in an eight-by-eight grid. At the start, each player (one controlling the white pieces, the other controlling the black pieces) controls sixteen pieces: one king, one queen, two rooks, two knights, two bishops, and eight pawns. The object of the game is to checkmate the opponent's king, whereby the king is under immediate attack (in "check") and there is no way for it to escape. There are also several ways a game can end in a draw

Chess: - Straight Knockout Competition. - Toss will be done to choose who starts first & the one who loses the toss will get to choose Black or White. - Format - Standard Blitz 5 mins each. - Once your timer ends, you'll lose. - No intentional draws are allowed. - In the case of a Technical Draw, the rematch will be done

Gaming Arena Rules & Format

In General Rules for Gaming Arena:

- Any Updates or Changes in the Event's Format will be informed by the Heads on the server.
- In case of any issues regarding Disconnection, Server Errors, Internet Problems, etc. need to be communicated to the Event Heads as soon as possible. Failure in doing so will not affect the result in any manner.
- If in circumstances of Foul Play & Cheating, any individual or team (even if one) are found guilty then they are disqualified. The Event Heads will take other related decisions & their verdict will be ultimate.
- All the participants should be On Time. A buffer period of maximum 4 minutes will be given to join the respective lobbies or custom rooms.
- The In-Game & Discord IDs of all the participants should be appropriate and not offensive in any manner.
- Finally yet importantly, 'Play Fair To Win With Flair!'

2. Room Code will be provided by the Hosts and the rules will be standard as enforced by the app.
3. No chatting or exchange of reactions will be allowed In-Game.
4. If the participants are kicked out due to Internet Issues, Hosts will not be held responsible for it.



Fun Games Rules and Format.

1. Rap Battle/Beat Boxing:

RULES:

1. Do not bite (copy) someone else work. Your freestyle must be 100% original material and shall not infringe upon any third-party copyrights, trademarks, or other intellectual property rights nor shall it contain any vulgar words and sexually explicit lyrics.
2. The language and dialect to be used in the battle is either English or Hindi.
3. The rap lyrics (punch line) should focus more on humor whether you mock or ridicule your opponent.
4. The organizer/promoter will appoint the timekeeper. He /She will be provided with a stopwatch and will be responsible for indicating the end of each round. The clock starts from the beginning of the first line spoken by the competitor.
5. For the preliminary round of competition, each emcee will be given two rounds each for one (1) minute, for the semi-final round each emcee rhymes twice for one (1) minute per round, in the final round each emcee rhymes twice for one (1) minute. In case of a tie, another round (OT) will be provided to break the tie.
6. Each Emcee must rhyme over the same beat as their opponent.
7. By participating in this event you permit the recording of your contributions and assign to the organizers the complete copyright and all other rights in your contributions for use in all media.
8. Competitors who are rude, abusive or deemed otherwise unsuitable by the organizers will be disqualified from the competition.

2. Murder Mystery:

Rules:

1. The story will be revealed in the WhatsApp group only, before the main event.
2. The participants have to solve the murder mystery and identify the murderer.
3. The participants also have to justify why they think the particular suspect is the murder on the day of main event.

6. Participation will be given the topic 10 minutes prior the event starts.


