- •The date and confirmation for the project were received by the core members on 11th August 2019.
- •All core team members contacted the schools and fixed dates for the meeting.

• Rtr. Hrishikesh Sawant along with core team members met the principal of the schools explained about the concept of *Vakratunda* project and then fixed the date and time for the workshop.

•Then Chairpersons explained the concept of a project and an arrangement for the project to the schools that agreed on doing it, like:

- We will charge Rs 40 to Rs 50 per student.
- No restrictions for age or standard of student.
- We will give a small gift to students who will make a really good idol and we'll be featuring its pictures on clubs

•A Letterhead was signed with each of the schools that participated well in advance.

- •After getting confirmations from school, the JPEG for the project was made by digital communication team.
- •On 20th August 2019 the final PR message and JPEG were received.
- •On 21st August 2019, the message was uploaded on all social media platforms.
- •A short message promoting the project was shared with everyone on the club's all social platforms.
- •Before each session, a reminder JPEG was circulated to all the district avenue and zonal WhatsApp groups by every club member.
- Rtr. Hrishikesh Sawant had made available the materials required for the idol-making workshop and then it was stored at his and Rtr. Sunad Pawar's place.
- •i.e. Shadu mud, paper plates, cups and toothpicks, etc. were bought a few days before the project.
- •The main raw material i.e Shadu mud was brought on each venue on the day of the project.
- After all this, we decided to do our last session of Vakratunda along with the clay modelling workshop in a girls orphanage which in is Kharghar itself named Prem Dan for free of cost.
- •We chose that only orphanage because we already did a few projects there and we have a really good bonding with those kids.

•We used to start our arrangements an hour before the session was assigned at every venue as it included mixing of the clay

arranging water for the same.

•Board of Directors were divided avenue wise and each avenue was given a particular session to attend due to which all the BODc would get a chance to be a part of the project

- All the club members helped in teaching the school kids the proper ways to make Ganesha idols from the mud that we had provided them i.e. Shadu Mud.
- Along with making these idols they were also explained the importance of an Eco-friendly idol.
- The children were supervised by the school staff who even helped in the idol making process.
- The event was captured in camera and the photos were uploaded on social media platforms.
- · After every session food was provided to every OC Member.
- A total of 774 idols were made by the following school students and staff.
